Superheroes

Art & Design: Superheroes

- To use a range of materials creatively to design and make a climbing superhero.
- To use drawing to develop and share their ideas, experiences and imagination.
- To develop a range of drawing techniques in using colour, pattern, line and shape.
- To use a range of materials creatively to design and make a superhero mask.
- . To practise the skill of cutting and using a template.
- . To ask questions about a piece of work.
- To use shapes to show different features on a face.
- To show how people feel in paintings and drawings.
- To describe what you see and give opinions about the work of artists.

Music: Music Superheroes

The skills taught in this unit are:

- To begin to find and internalise the pulse.
- To copy back and improvise rhythms.
- To recognise how the pitch shows us how high or low a sound is.
- To recognise how dynamics show how loud or soft sound is.
- To recognise how tempo changes the speed of music.
- To begin to understand how pulse, rhythm, pitch, tempo, dynamics and notation work together to create music.
- To begin to understand how structure, timbre and texture work together.
- To sing songs and speak chants and rhymes.
- To work together in a group.
- To perform with confidence to an audience.

Computing: We are storytellers

- To understand how a talking book differs from a paper-based book.
- To plan an audio book.
- To use sound recording equipment to record sounds.
- To develop skills in saving and storing sounds on the computer.
- To upload sounds and images to create an audiobook.
- To share recordings with an audience and reflect on others' work.

E-safety

• To begin to identify characteristics of people who are trustworthy.

PHSE: Changes

• To think about how I have changed since I was a baby and how I can be ready for Year 2.

Relationships Education

- To know how to use my words to keep myself safe.
- To know the difference between secrets and surprises and to not keep any secret that makes them feel uncomfortable, anxious or afraid.
- To know what is meant by privacy, their right to keep things private and the importance of respecting another's privacy.
- To know that people's feelings and bodies can be hurt.



PE:

Indoors: Dance – imoves (superheroes)

- To explore moving in time to the music thinking about the space.
- To explore different feelings in my movements.
- To explore how to show a different hero in my movements.
- To be able perform basic movements to music to build a simple dance.
- To perform short dance sequences, using travel, turn, jump, gesture, pause and fall, to express and communicate my ideas and feelings
- To transfer knowledge and understanding from topic to PE.

Outdoor: Athletics

- To explore different ways of travelling: hop, skip, jump, gallop & leap.
- To change the length of my stride when I travel.
- To be able to change direction using small steps.
- To be able to take off and land using bent knees and arms for power.
- To be able to show a jump for height.
- To be able to show a jump for length.
- To be able to throw different objects at a target.

History: *History Heroes*

- To read the story of Rosa Parks and put the events into the correct order.
- To find out who Rosa Parks was and why she was famous.
- To explain how Rosa Parks made things better for people.
- To find out about Emily Davison and order the events of her life.
- To ask questions about Emily Davison and how she helped people to have better lives and with support find answers.
- To know how the lives of Emily Davison and Rosa Parks were different due to the time period in which they lived.
- To be able to talk about Emily Davison and Rosa Parks and sort who did what to help us have better lives.

Geography:

No focus this half term.

RE: Judaism

- To know what Jews believe about God.
- To identify a mezuzah and know why it is important to Jewish people.
- To understand the importance of Abraham to Jewish people.
- To explore the story of Moses in the bulrushes.
- To understand the importance of Moses to Jewish people.
- To say who is important to me and why.

D&T:

Science:

- To name parts of the human body they can see.
- Draw and label basic parts of the human body.
- Identify the main parts of the human body and link them to their senses
