- Always use cursive letters.
- Always join your handwriting but make sure that your teacher can read your work.
- Leave finger spaces between your words.
- Make sure t, l, d, h, k, b stand tall.
- Make sure q, y, p, f, g, j, go below the line.
- Make sure all other letters are the same size.
- No letters round the wrong way.

If you can show that you can do all of these things consistently in all of your work you will become a Handwriting Hero!
