## Can I Tell You a Story?

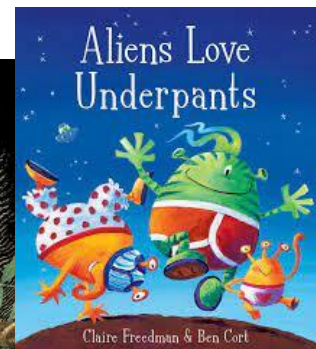
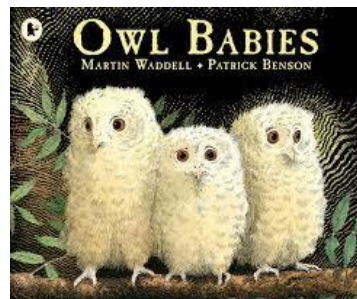
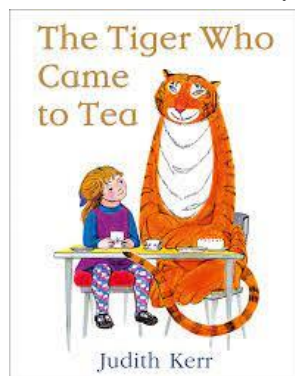
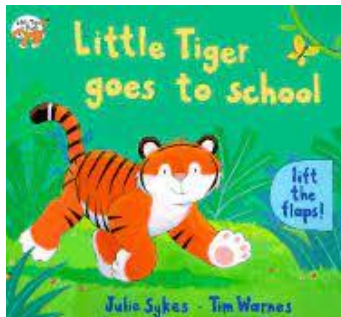


### I need to know and remember that:

- An author is the person who writes the story.



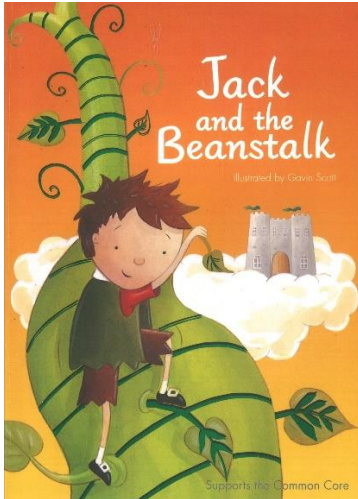
- Stories have a beginning, middle and an end.



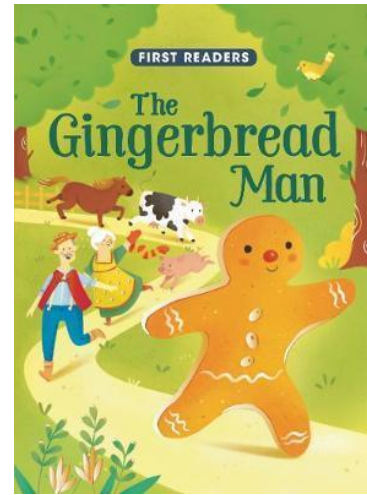
- Stories may begin with 'Once upon a time...'

To help my learning I need to know and remember the words that are used in the story again and again.

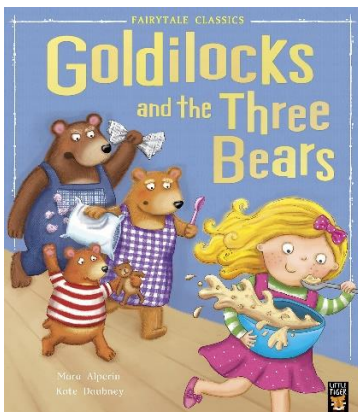
"Fee, fi, fo, fum watch out now, here I come!"



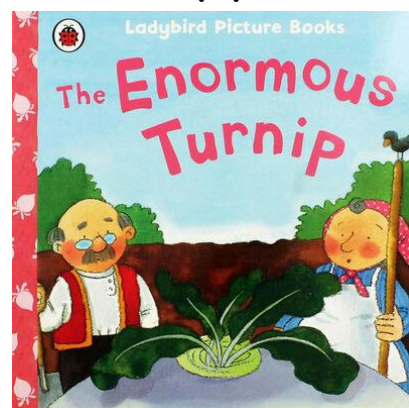
"Run, run as fast as you can. You can't catch me I'm the gingerbread man!"
