**Key Facts**

<b>How have you changed since you were born?</b>	You have grown taller. You can do more things by yourself now. You eat different food and can drink more different things. You used to crawl and you can walk around.
<b>How have games and toys changed over time?</b>	Old games and toys were often made of wood or metal. Modern games and toys might be made of wood, metal or plastic.

**Key Vocabulary**

<b>A long time ago</b>	Something in the past. Often we use this to mean something from before you were born, when your grandparents were children.
<b>Memory</b>	Something that we can still think about from the <b>past</b> .
<b>New</b>	Something from the <b>present</b> .
<b>Old</b>	Something from the <b>past</b> .
<b>Past</b>	Something that has already happened.
<b>Present</b>	Something that is happening now.
<b>Remember</b>	When we think about something that happened in the <b>past</b> .
