



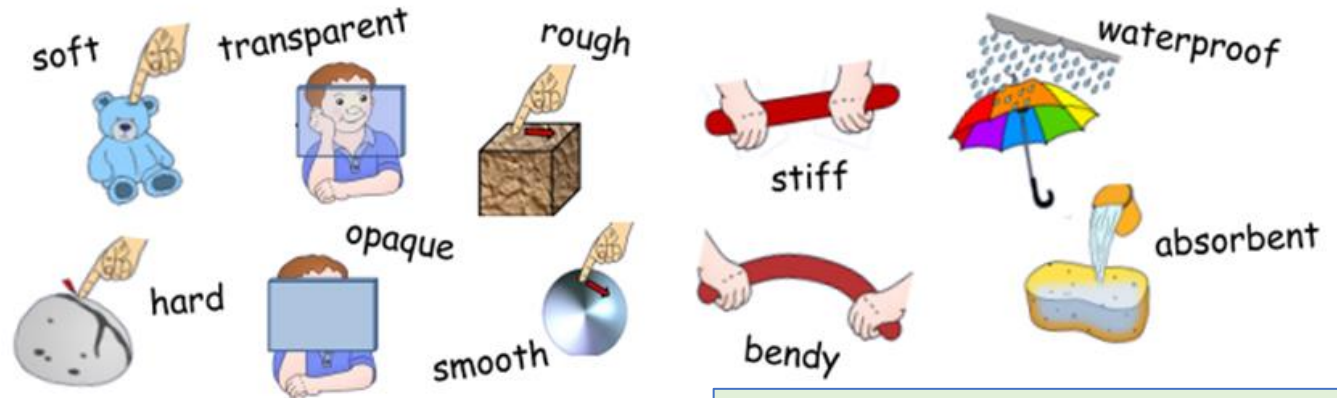
## Science – Year 1

Different **materials** have different **physical properties** which make them useful for different things. A **property** is a quality that describes what something is like or how it behaves.

<b>glass</b> 	<b>clay</b> 
<b>metal</b> 	<b>foil</b> 
<b>water</b> 	<b>cardboard</b> 
<b>rock</b> 	<b>rubber</b> 
<b>brick</b> 	<b>wool</b>
