#### Why is a mosque a special place for Muslims?

The mosque is a place to gather for prayers, to study and to celebrate festivals such as **Ramadan**. It can also be used to house schools and community centres.

#### What is inside a mosque and what happens there?

**Mosques** are places where **Muslims** worship, they are an open area of prayer in Islam. No music or singing is allowed inside a mosque, though professional chanters (qurrā) may chant the **Qur'ān**.





#### What happens at Ramadan?

During the month of **Ramadan**, **Muslims** won't eat or drink between dawn and sunset. This is called fasting. Fasting is important during **Ramadan** as it allows **Muslims** to think about their faith and come closer to **Allah**. **Ramadan** is also a time for prayer, doing good things and spending time with family and friends.

#### How do Muslims celebrate Eid-ul-Fitr?

The festival day begins with the first sighting of the new moon at the beginning of the tenth month of the Islamic calendar. **Muslims** wear their best clothes, decorate their homes and spend time celebrating with their friends and family. Some **Muslims** may give money to the poor so that they can also enjoy the day.
