Key Vocabulary

Erosion

The process by which soil and rock is removed from one area of the Earth through natural causes such as wind, water, and ice and transported elsewhere.

Land use

The way that land is used. This might be for farming, places that people live or places which are used

Key Facts

Where is Black Gang Chine?

Blackgang Chine is found on the Isle of Wight to the south of the island.

How is erosion affecting Black Gang Chine?

Around 3.5 meters of land is lost from Blackgang Chine each year (although it is not continual or consistent). This means that rides regularly have to be moved, or they will fall into the sea. This can be a very expensive and continuous process.
