Expressionism


- Started at the beginning of the 20th Century (1900) in Germany.

Van Gogh



DOB: 30th March 1853–30th July 1890

Nationality: Dutch from the Netherlands. Spent a lot of years in France.

Mediums he used (refer to both to the

Van Gogh mostly used oil paints, with a distinctive flicking technique. He did also use charcoal and water-colour.
