Wassily Kandinsky



DOB: 16th December 1866–
13th December 1944

Nationality: Born in Moscow Russia. Became a French citizen in 1939

Mediums he used (refer to both to the type of art (e.g. painting, sculpture, printmaking), as well as the materials an artwork is made from).

Kandinsky often made his own paints using a choice of vivid colours and pigments. He used with oil, watercolour, gouache, tempera, and possibly mixtures of these media. He painted on canvas, wood and even glass.

FUN FACT: Kandinsky was a very tidy , formal man. He was always seen wearing a suit, even when painting in his studio.
