Movement (A style of art followed by a group of artists during a certain period in time)


Abstract Art


Concentric Circles 1913

Kandinsky often made his own paints using a choice of vivid colours and pigments. He used with oil, watercolour, gouache, tempera, and possibly mixtures of these media. He painted on canvas, wood and even glass.
