**Movement** (A style of art followed by a group of artists during a certain period in time)

**Modern Art/Modernism**

- Refers to artistic works produced from the 1860s to about the 1970s.
- Traditions of the past thrown aside in a spirit of experimentation. Modern artists experimented with new ways of seeing and with fresh ideas.
- More recent artistic production is often called Contemporary art



**DOB:** 30th July 1898 –31st Aug 1986  
**Nationality:** British, Yorkshire

**Mediums he used** ( refer to both to the type of art (e.g. painting, sculpture, printmaking), as well as the materials an artwork is made from).

Best known for recreating sculptures made from cast bronze. His semi-abstract sculptures, mostly of the human figure, are characterized by their smooth, organic shape, often depicting small heads and elongated limbs.

However, he also produced lots of drawing, printmaking and textile designs.

**FUN FACT:** In WWII Moore's studio was bombed and materials were hard to come by, so he turned to drawing as a commissioned war artist.
