On Thursday, they will hand in their donated book and receive a 'book token' which they will then be able to swap for one book. If your child would like to bring in more than one book, we would be very grateful, as any donated books that remain at the end of the day will be distributed to class book corners.

The aim of the 'Barrow Book Swap' is all about supporting children in developing a love of reading for pleasure. We hope that this will give children an incentive to keep reading new books as well as learning about the value of recycling.
